STRONG ALE

7% ABV and 27 IBUs

This delicately balanced strong ale starts with dark copper color mixed with slight reddish hues and a light tan head. Big malty aroma with a Munich character give way to a slight caramel & toffee mixed with spicy noble hop aroma, all wrapped together with a medium-bodied mouth feel. German malt flavor profile with slight roasty notes give it a subtle toffee sweetness balanced with spicy hop bitterness.



ESPRESSO MILK STOUT

5.6% ABV and 28 IBUs

Combines the local talents of their brewing and Stumptown coffee in a deliciously smooth, very Northwestern beer. Beer and coffee are Seattle siblings, jealously dividing the day. Split Shot will open your eyes to the talents of these local brewers and roasters.



IPA

6.9% ABV and 70 IBUs

This IPA was formally known as SAM named after its hops; Simcoe, Amarillo and Mosaic, but they were told this would be a trademark issue with a large craft brewery out of the north-east, so they had to change it. They cycled through a bunch of generic names; Bob, Tom, Dick, Dan, Carl, Frank until they finally arrived on the perfect name for this IPA...Joe.



IMPERIAL IPA

8.2% ABV and 73 IBUs

From their Manic IPA series, Space Dust is totally nebular! The hopping is pure starglow energy, with Chinook to bitter and late and dry additions of Citra and Amarillo.
